The history of Iran's Hockey



- Iran's hockey first started its work back in 1996, at first it was only inline hockey.
- Iran's first ice hockey team was formed back in 2020 when the first standrd ice rink started its work.



Inline hockey history

- The first inline hockey team was formed back in 1996
- Inline hockey league of Iran started its work from 2006
- The first round of Inline hockey league started with only 5 Teams and now there are 8 activeTeams
- Iran's inline league was held in both men and women. The Women's premier league and Women's first division league. The same was for the mens league.





Ice hockey history

It has always been a dream for Iranian inline players to have a standard ice rink, the players have attended some ice hockey camps in different countries until 2020 that the first ice hockey rink was made in Iranmall.

Since then the ice hockey team has started its work immediately. The ice rink started its work as an academy to train players and do advertising and attract as many players as possible and introduce this sport field.

Also after the membership in IIHF the national teams training started once a week for both men and women.

Ice hockey league have been going on for three years , the first year there were only 4 Teams in women and 4 Teams in mens league but right now there are 7 mens team and 6 womens Team.









Number of Hockey Players

Since the beginning of Inline hockey it all started with very little active players and in all these years we have reached 600 active players in inline which 70% were men and only 30% were women.

However since the beginning of ice hockey we only started with 30 senior active players but right now we have attracted 700 active players in three years which 40% of them are men and the other 60% are women in most ages, not only seniors.

Icebox Academy

Icebox Academy started its work with only 10 players in senior women's team and 10 players in U18 men's team.

Exactly three years ago we started to attract hockey players. Back then no one knew about hockey they just came to learn ice skating.

We used some recruitment models such as :

- Advertising and introducing hockey via the screens around the rink
- Participation of adults national team in international competitions
- Live television broadcast of hockey games
- Formation of families and coaches association
- Training coaches from interested participants
