- Arena Medical Room

- Connected with rubber floor matting from the ice surface to the dressing rooms and Medical Room
- At least 1 Treatment table
- 2 Treatment tables with dividers (WM, WM20 and WM18)
- Equipped with diagnostic instruments specified in the IIHF Medical Guidelines
- Equipped with orthopedic supplies specified in the IIHF Medical Guidelines
- Equipped with first aid supplies specified in the IIHF Medical Guidelines
- Equipped with office supplies specified in the IIHF Medical Guidelines

Ambulance

An ambulance shall be present during all games and practice times and shall be equipped with appropriate supplies to:

- Perform cardiopulmonary resuscitation; and

- Stabilize a suspected spinal or head injury, including a 210 cm spinal board or scoop with head and neck stabilizer.

Laboratory and Imaging Services

Imaging Services and Laboratory available for competing players on priority bases (not imperative on-site except for WM)

- X-Ray, MRI, C-Arm, CT, Fluoroscopy, Ultrasound
- Urinalysis and blood analysis (hospital or private laboratories)

- Reserved seat with good view of the game from all angles
- Benches reachable within shortest time, or
- Communication system with players' bench provided
- WM, WW, WM20: communication with IIHF Sport System

- Separate first aid room and staff dedicated to the spectators

Doping Control Facilities

- Separated processing room (DCS) and waiting room
- a. Doping Control Station*
- Secure and lockable rooms;
- One (1) table and four (4) chairs around it for the sample collection

- One (1) separate table and one (1) chair, which shall serve as a working space; □ □
- Internet connection and a laptop (WM only); □ □
- One (1) separate toilet and wash basin, equipped with mirrors, which shall be big enough for the player and a witness being inside at same time during the sample collection procedure; □ □
- One (1) table for the sample collection vessel selection; □ □
- One (1) lockable refrigerator for storing the doping control samples; □ □
- One (1) secure and lockable cabinet for the storage of forms, and; □ □
- One (1) bed for players during blood sample collection. □ □

- Space for 10-12 people inside at the same time □ □

- One (1) refrigerator for non-alcoholic drinks in sealed bottles. □ □
