Competition Manipulation

4 main components:

- 1. Matchfixing
- 2. Betting
- 3. Sharing Inside Information
- 4. Reporting

Matchfixing

Underperforming on purpose Ensuring a pre-determined outcome

- Approached by Medical Staff, Friends, Referees, Coaches, Strangers
- Ask for information on team, injury, to lose on purpose
- Offered to resolve an issue, money, holiday, car



Sporting

The Athlete underperforms in order to face an easier opponent in the next round of the tournament or because nothing is at stake in the game.

Money

When bets are placed on the game, the game is manipulated in order to fit the bet and generate money.

Betting

Legal sports betting is nothing bad in of itself, on the contrary, it is a major source of income for sports through sponsorship.

BUT the risk of competition manipulation is high.





DO NOT:

- Bet on ANY ice hockey games
- Help anyone with betting on ice hockey games
- When participating in a multi-sport event, never bet on any of the sports of that event

Inside Information

DO NOT share inside information

- Approached by Medical Staff, Friends, Referees, Coaches, Strangers
- Ask for information on team, injury, to lose on purpose
- Offered to resolve an issue, money, holiday, car
- Be cautious on Social Media



Reporting

It is **YOUR** duty to ALWAYS REPORT any suspicious behaviour

Not reporting can be considered as manipulation

Friends, retired athletes, family, sponsors, criminals Direct influence on the competition:

- Athletes
- Referees
- Coaches

INTERNAL PEOPLE:

Coaches, managers, agents, club owners, players, competition organisers.
