





Season 22-23

- More close results (1-2 goals difference)
- More games in OT / SO
- Less games 3-4 and +5 goals difference
- Expected goals for/against trendline is closer (goal: +/- 40-60%)





YOUTH HOCKEY / DEVELOPMENT FURTHER ANALYTICS

Basic analytics

- Licensed players boys/girls at any age group per year
- → Dropouts
- → Tendencies (more, less players?, Relative Age Effect?, etc.)

Advanced stats / analytics

- TOI% at level change (same player U17 → U20)
- TOI% juniors in senior leagues
- Impact of players from U17-Elit and higher (xGF, xGA, TOI special teams, TOI close results, etc.)
- ... and other analytics in progress / testing phase

Physical meetings

- Meetings with organisations 1x per year (club visits)
- Meetings with all age group coaches 1x per year at «Elit» Levels (eg. 24 U15-Elit Coaches)
- 2x per year "Talent and Ambition" reunion (Head of development, youth GM, etc.)
- → Mix from analytics, discussions/feedbacks and field visits for further development of pathway
