THE TEN GOLDEN RULES FOR FAIR PLAY IN ICE HOCKEY FOR COACHES

I WILL ...

- 1. Respect and champion the rights of every player, official and staff member participating in ice hockey.
- 2. Develop relationships with my players based on openness, honesty, mutual trust and respect. I will treat each player equally.
- 3. Demonstrate proper personal behavior at all times. I will lead by example and teach fair play, respect and good sportsmanship during practices and in games.
- 4. Refrain from yelling at players, officials and opponents. I will not insult others or use vulgar language. I will respect the dignity, rights, and worth of everyone involved in ice hockey, regardless of their race, gender, ability, cultural background or religion.
- 5. Always put player development first and winning second. I will be a mentor for my players and provide guidance that goes beyond ice hockey related concerns.
- 6. Have a positive attitude and create positive experiences for my players during practices and games.
- 7. Provide safe and risk-free practices which are adapted to the developmental stage of my players. I will only have physical contact with players if such is appropriate to the situation and necessary for the development of the players.
- 8. Promote fair play. I will not tolerate doping, cheating or any actions that might be considered unfair.
- 9. Treat injured and sick players with caution and concern. I will always follow the instructions of the physicians and doctors.
- 10. Refrain from drinking alcohol before or during practices or games. The usage of drugs has no place in ice hockey.
