## I WILL ...

- 1. Know all playing rules, their interpretations and their proper application. I will strive to create a safe and sportsmanlike environment in which players can properly display their hockey skills.
- 2. Be honest, consistent, objective, impartial and respectful when officiating a game.
- 3. Avoid or put an end to any situation that threatens the safety of the players. I will cooperate with players and coaches to provide a positive and safe experience for all participants.
- 4. Not tolerate unacceptable behavior and verbal or physical abuse towards officials, other players, spectators or myself.
- 5. Be open to discussions and contact with players and coaches before and after a game. I will accept constructive criticism and show respect and consideration for different points of view. I will use honesty and integrity when answering all reasonable questions and requests.
- 6. Respect the dignity, rights, and worth of everyone involved in ice hockey, regardless of their race, gender, ability, cultural background or religion.
- 7. Always act as a team player and cooperate with colleagues and supervisors, for the benefit of the game.
- 8. Maintain my health and physical fitness through a conditioning program for the betterment of my officiating skills.
- 9. Never engage in any conduct that is contrary to integrity and ethical values. I will immediately report any potential integrity or ethical misconduct that I witness.
- 10. Refrain from officiating when I am under influence of alcohol. The usage of drugs has no place in ice hockey.
