2. Encourage my child to play by the rules, respect their teammates, their coaches, their opponent and the officials.
3. Demonstrate proper personal behavior and conduct at all times. I will always set a good example.
4. Applaud every good effort, play and performance, no matter by which team or player it was made.
5. Teach my child that effort and engagement are more important than winning. I will encourage my child to learn from his/her mistakes.
6. Support all efforts to remove verbal and physical abuse from ice hockey.
7. Promote fair play. I will not tolerate doping, cheating or any actions that might be considered unfair.
8. Refrain from criticizing my child, other players, coaches and officials. I will not insult others or use vulgar language.
9. Respect the dignity, rights, and worth of everyone involved in ice hockey, independent of their race, gender, ability, cultural background or religion.
10. Encourage my child to refrain from drinking alcohol or using drugs. I will be moderate and prudent with my alcohol consumption.
