- 1. Always play within the rules of ice hockey and the spirit of the game.
- 2. Not argue with officials. If I disagree with a decision, I will inform my team's captain or coach during a break or after the game.
- 3. Control my temper. I understand that verbal abuse of officials and other players, or deliberately distracting or provoking an opponent, is not acceptable.
- 4. Work equally hard for myself as for my team. Both my performance and my team's performance will benefit from my hard work and dedication.
- 5. Be a good sport and applaud all good plays, even when they are made by the opponent. I will display modesty in victory and graciousness in defeat.
- 6. Treat everyone in the same manner that I would like to be treated. I will not bully or take unfair advantage of someone. I will respect the rights, dignity, and worth of everyone regardless of their race, gender, ability, cultural background or religion.
- 7. Cooperate with my coach, teammates, opponents and officials. Without them there would be no games. Therefore, I will thank them at the end of each game.
- 8. Participate for my own enjoyment and benefit, not just to please my parents or coaches.
- 9. Promote fair play and respect the integrity of the game. I will comply with anti-doping and competition manipulation policies.
- 10. Refrain from drinking alcohol before or during practices or games. The usage of drugs has no place in ice hockey.
